

Hello! From my home in the Sierra Nevada foothills I have been leading trips large and small for almost 20 years. Destinations have included Ecuador, Alaska, Iceland, Bhutan and Tanzania. I share over 40 years of experience as a published photographer and 20 years of teaching photography at the college level, along with a sense of fun, adventure and understanding of photographic challenges. For my international trips, I am extremely careful about selecting reputable companies that offer excellent value, great accommodations and transportation. Slovenia: In early May, get far from the madding crowds of western Europe and savor this tiny Eastern European country, complete with cathedrals, castles, alpine peaks and great food.

Alaska: This is my twentieth year of leading small-boat trips in Southeast Alaska. This year July trip focuses on whales and gorgeous wilderness. My co-leader is Juneau resident Mark Kelley, perhaps Alaska's most famous photographer.

Namibia: This southwestern African country features the tallest sand dunes in the world, eerie sand-filled ghost towns, abundant wildlife and much, much more. For this August trip I am partnering with Lewis Kemper, formerly a Canon Explorer of Light, one of the highest photographic accolades in the world.

Bodie: (date to be announced, although we're hoping for late September to coincide with the new moon for optimal Milky Way photography). I've been leading trips to this artifact-choked ghost town on the eastern side of the Sierras since 2003. We're among the few groups to get inside the dusty old buildings.
