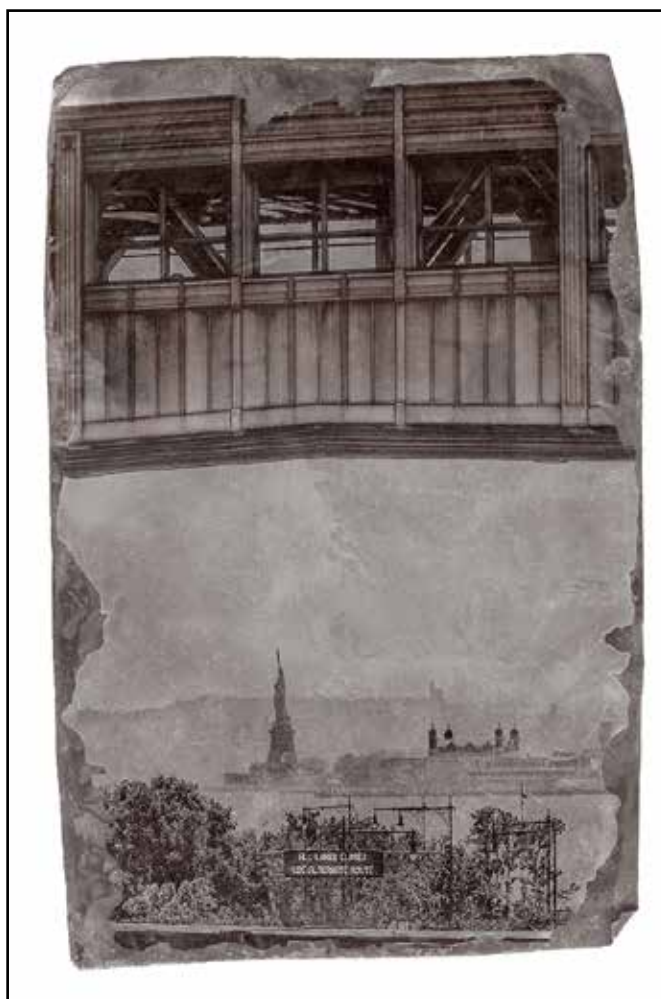

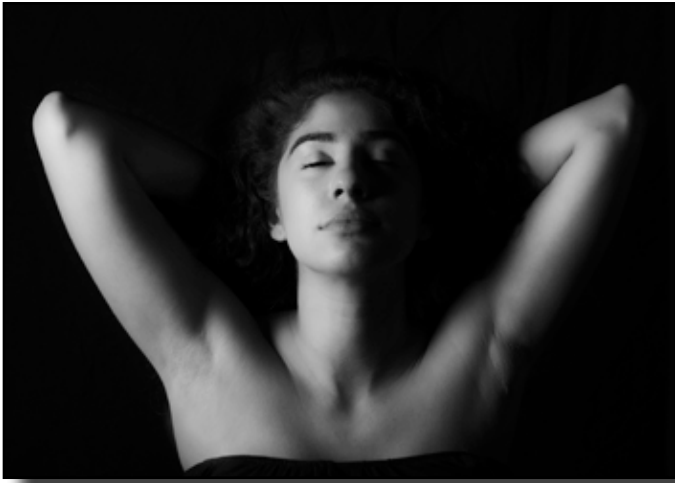

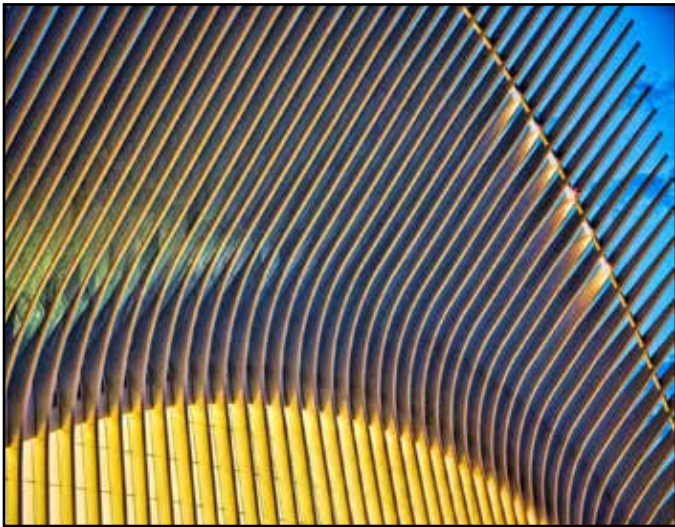

Jeff Cable is an inspiring speaker, no matter what aspects of photography he chooses to cover. He is best known for his artistic passion, his easy-going attitude and his ability to capture the emotion of any moment. His photography from portraits to sports to travel is exceptional. Jeff also teaches photography to photo enthusiasts and professionals around the world, including Africa, Australia, China, Europe, South America, and across the United States. He is one of the most watched and respected instructors of photography, with millions of viewers of his free online photography classes. He also writes weekly in his photography blog, which is read by more than 60,000 people a month.

On May 2nd Dave Henry will be conducting an evening workshop on Alcatraz. This isn't one of our Live Learning events because the National Park permitting process doesn't allow Canon enough time to put it on the website. This is a rare event. I have been trying to secure a permit for this workshop over a year.

We will have the island to ourselves from 6:30 pm to 10:30 pm with four rangers, with keys, to allow access to anywhere we want to go on the island, including the shops, kitchen, showers and basements dating back to the Civil War!

We leave the Embarcadero at 6 pm sharp and will return by 11 pm.

The cost is only \$219 per photographer. There is very limited space on the shuttle boat so make a decision as soon as you can. With only two weeks until the class, once you've committed, there's no refunds unless you can find a replacement or someone from the wait list takes your place.
