Before Tom and Sally Myers became professional photographers for books, advertising and magazines they had a thriving art business creating sculptures.

Fifty years ago they sold their work in Carmel, San Francisco and Sacramento Galleries. Going back to their roots they have again embarked on making their wood sculptures. No new materials are used. Any color in the buildings comes from the original paint on the wood.

Finding the materials for their projects is much more difficult these days. Cities are too successful in their recycling operations. All soft drink cans are now made our of aluminum. Also any old wood from buildings being demolished is immediately placed in dumpsters.



Tom and Sally report that finding the material takes some resourcefulness. These days they often search for piles of old rusted tin and wood with the help of Google Earth. Whatever they find usable is turned into early day scenes of California as well as animals, birds and insects. The Myers, of course, always have their cameras with them so they are ready for photo possibilities too!!
