


home is daylight correct, K-5000, perfect for taking pictures.

To me, still life photography is taking a subject and seeing how many ways you can capture the essence or transform the subject to play a focal role in a new scene. Lighting, both reflective and direct and the use of background or supporting materials become essential props.

I will deliver a digital slide program demonstrating the diversity of still life photography and a different dimension of photographic discovery. This will be followed by a 'how to set up' a temporary 'Studio' in your home complete with lighting on our stage.

I was introduced to the art of still life photography several years ago while taking a macro photography class in Missoula, Montana. It awakened me to the fact that I could still do photography on those cold wet wintery days. The new challenge became an entirely different application of my skills as macro photographer. I soon looked forward to studio still life work even on those pleasant spring days. Our kitchen, complete with an island cabinet became my studio complete with an overhead bank of ceiling fluorescent lighting. All of the lighting in our
