

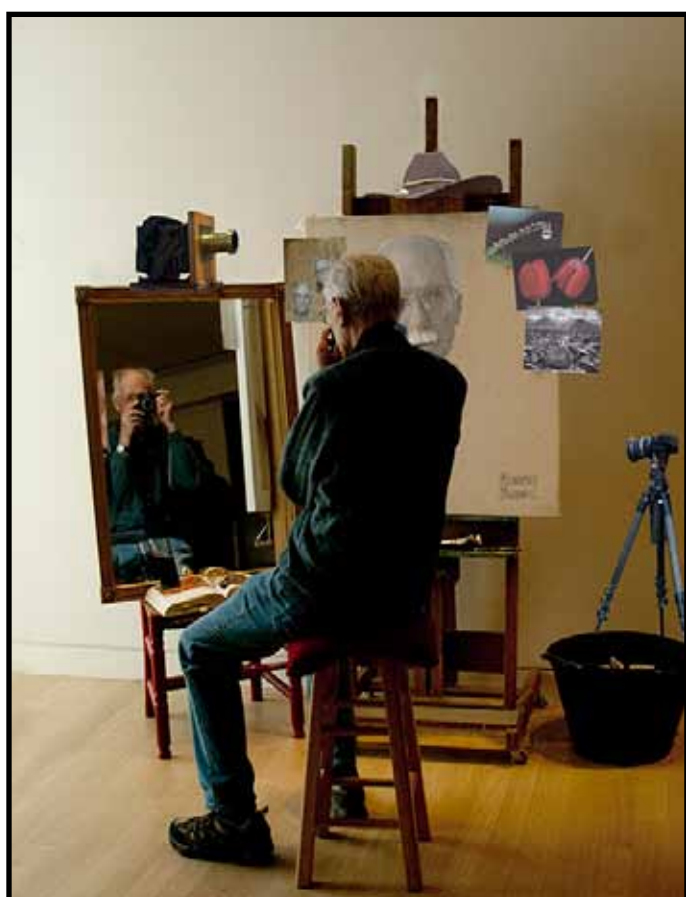

March program night will be on the second Tuesday, March 12th. Mr. Sam Shaw will be

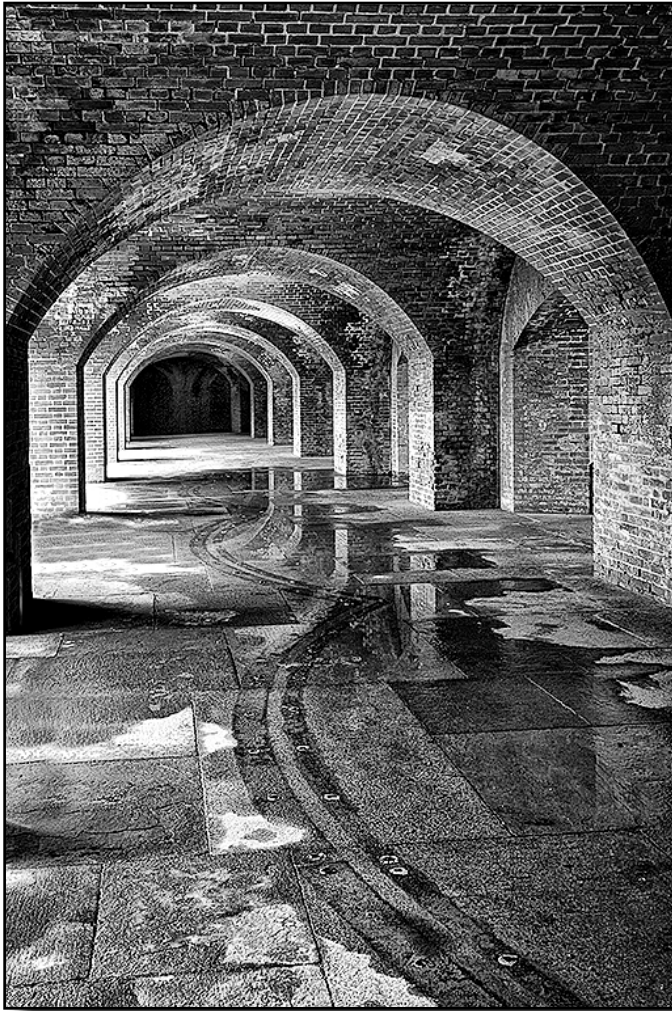
presenting on the elements of night photography, “The Twilight Zone and Beyond”.

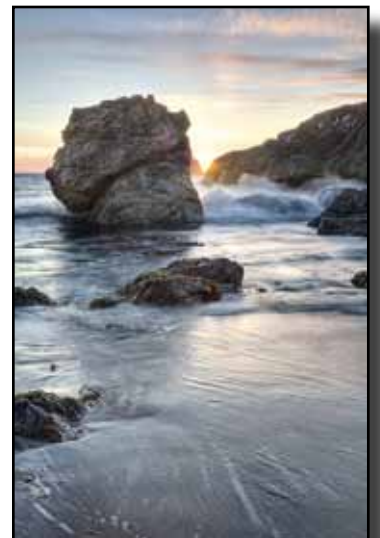
