

- 3. A list should be provided to Barbara with either the images numbered or named and the price.

There will be print racks, a couple of wire stands for hanging and a circular card rack for cards.

You can bring your prints to one of the March Meetings or on Fri. March 18th, contact Barbara.

HELP IS NEEDED on the days of the sale. There will be a sign up at the next meeting or contact Barbara. We also get a discount if someone is available to work with the event planning committee during the show. The show is well advertised and has a large attendance.
