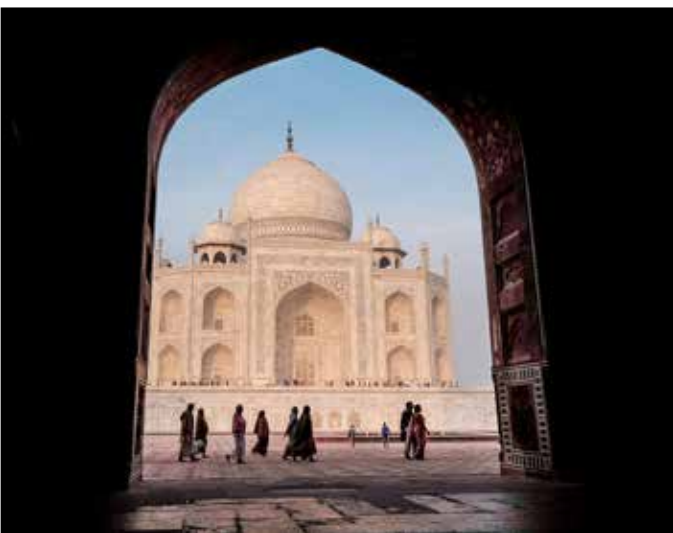

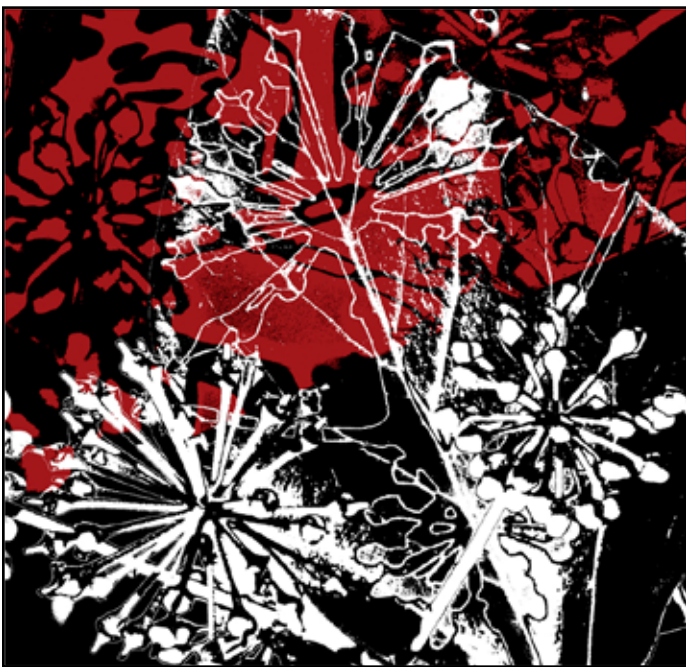

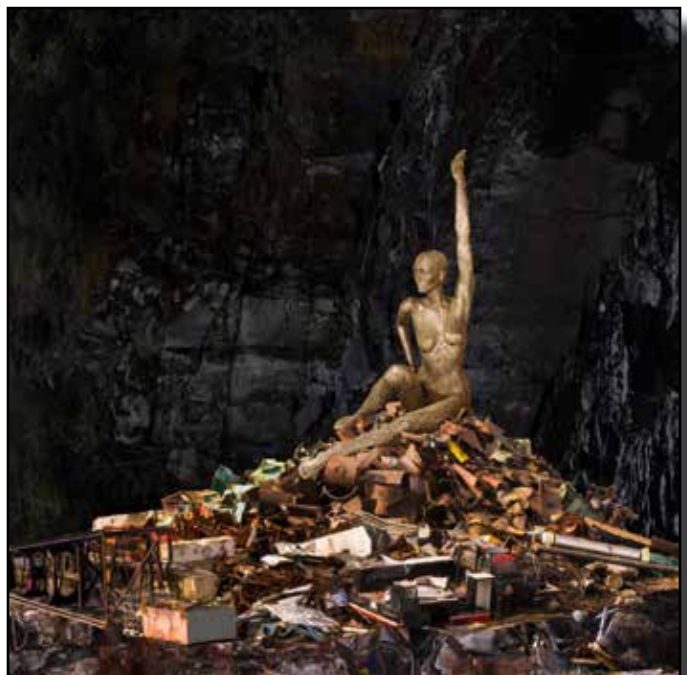

1. The prints must be in a plastic sleeve and should either be matted or have a backing. (see below)
2. Attach labels with the name of the maker, price etc. to the plastic sleeve. You may also insert information about the print, your card or information inside the back of the sleeve or attached to the back of the print.

3. A list should be provided to Barbara with either the images numbered or named and the price.

There will be print racks, a couple of wire stands for hanging and a circular card rack for cards.

You can bring your prints to one of the March Meetings or on Fri. March 18th, contact Barbara.

HELP IS NEEDED on the days of the sale. There will be a sign up at the next meeting or contact Barbara. We also get a discount if someone is available to work with the event planning committee during the show. The show is well advertised and has a large attendance.
