



Amy was a proficient photographer and a dedicated worker for any of the organizations to which she belonged. Over the years she has been a member of the Hub Camera Club in Marysville, CA; the Sierra Camera Club in Sacramento, the Gold Rush Chapter of PSA, and PSA.

Amy joined PSA in 1985 and was awarded her APSA in 2000. She was the Editor and Writer of International News, PSA Journal from 1998-2004, and she enjoyed her contact with many of the international members. She was still keeping in touch with many of those she came to know over the years. In the PSA International Newsletter Contest, she received the Hendricks Award for the Best Entries—Gold Rush Chapter, Amy McMillan, Editor in 1998. In 1998 & 1999, the Gold Rush Chapter was the First Place Winner, Amy McMillan Editor. She also did the 2000 PSA International Catalog, which is a big job.

Amy received several Editorial Star Awards for writings in the PSA Journal. She received her first Bronze Star in 1996; her 2nd-4th Bronze Stars in 1999, and her 1st Silver Star in 2000 and 2nd Silver Star in 2003.

Besides being the editor of the Gold Rush newsletter for many years, Amy was the Secretary from 1999-2001 and then the Membership Chairman for several years.

She and her beloved husband, Neil, who died 4 years ago, loved to travel and went to Europe, the British Isles, Mexico, Alaska, and many other places. Many of her best and favorite pictures were taken on their travels. She was always willing to share her experiences with others and to help new members.
