

SCC Member Donn Reiners Presented a very entertaining program at the August General Meeting.







Donn Reiners presented a photograph essay of flowers consisting of two slide presentations. The first was a photographic essay of the plant family 'Geraniaceae' (geraniums) followed by a slide show featuring Cacti and Succulents. Donn is an expert horticulturist and has been an avid grower of Geraniums since 1946 growing well over 5000 varieties. His photography of Geraniums is featured in newspapers, books, television and the internet worldwide. The varieties of Geraniums were truly amazing. He brought some Geraniums from around the world that most of us would not have recognized as Geraniums.

Cacti and Succulents are a more recent addition to his plant collection and are wonderful subjects for photography. His images are usually taken at noon, when the defused light is perfect in his large climate controlled greenhouse. Donn is a true expert and dedicated to learning everything about his subject. He knows the native climate of each plant and places it in one of the six climate areas of his greenhouse. WOW!
